For our 20th Annual Studio 320 Recital we will celebrate our amazing & hard-working dancers with 2 huge shows at the Music Hall in downtown Kansas City! It's such a special occasion for our kids and teachers - and a fun and memorable experience for all 320 family, friends & fans!

Studio 320 recitals are BIG events, with professional sound, lighting, and incredible talent! From our "Tiny Twos" to our Seniors (we have 8 graduates this year!) you will see dancing that will melt your heart and blow your mind!

We've created this handbook in an effort to clarify details and lay out a plan of attack for the coming weeks. We still have a lot to accomplish before we take the stage!

Philosophy, Policies & Procedures

Recital is a rite of passage for our devoted students! It provides them the opportunity to showcase the results of a year's hard work, dedication & progress, in a professional and exciting environment. A big part of dance training is learning through stage performance. These opportunities not only help prepare students desiring a further career in dance, but they also contribute to children's success in non-dance activities. The performing experience helps build self-esteem and self-confidence and can result in better school presentations, improved social skills, and strong interview skills for future college or job opportunities.

The in-class rehearsal process is a tremendous learning experience as well. It helps the children develop retention skills, and by working with their classmates on a group performance, they learn the positive aspects of teamwork!

THE COMMITMENT

By allowing your child to participate in the Studio 320 Recital, you commit yourself and/or your child to the following dates & events.

- November 19** Recital Costume Deposits charged via ePay. All costumes \$50.
- March 20** Recital Costume Balances charged via ePay. All costumes \$30 plus tax
- April 8-11** **Costume Distribution Week**
Parents attend the last 15 minutes of your Recital class to receive costume & details. All accounts must be paid in full to receive costumes.
- April 20** Last day to turn in Recital T-Shirt Orders
- April 20** **Recital Picture Day** (See attached schedule)
Imagine Dance will be back at Studio 320 taking class and individual pictures this season! You will be able to order picture packages at the studio this day.
- April 29** **Tuesday: Recital Tickets Go On Sale**
Tickets will be available for purchase starting at 5:00 PM at Studio 320's front desk. Tickets must be purchased in person, not by phone. You may send a friend or family member to purchase your tickets if needed. There is NO LIMIT on tickets. There will not be the option to purchase ticket at the door on recital nights. Tickets are \$15 each, same as last year. Performers do NOT need a ticket. All parents/family/siblings (age 4+) DO need a ticket.
- April 20** Last day to turn in "Backstage Mom" Volunteer forms at the 320 Front Desk
- April 29-May 2** **In-Class Dress Rehearsal!**
Send your dancer to class wearing costume. Parents should attend last 15 minutes of class to receive additional info and to video your routine for at-home practice. (Please bring additional costumes in a GARMENT BAG if you have multiple classes in one night.) Do not wear competition costumes to classes this week, only recital costumes!
- May 6-9** Final week of regular classes! **Mandatory attendance** for all recital performers!

PICTURE DAY HAIR & MAKEUP:

LIGHT STAGE MAKEUP & LIGHT LIPSTICK - HAIR CAN BE STYLED ANY WAY YOU LIKE!

PICTURE DAY IMPORTANT NOTES!

ARRIVE 15 MINUTES BEFORE your scheduled class picture time. We will not be able to wait for late arrivals. If you miss your group picture, you may still get your individual picture taken!

ARRIVE PHOTO READY

Walk into the studio wearing your first costume, with hair, makeup, accessories, tights and shoes! There will be dressing rooms set up for those who have multiple costume changes.

PHOTOS (AND ALL NEW “MEMORY BOOK”) PACKAGES

Order forms will be available upon arrival through our Photo/Video vendor, **IMAGINE DANCE**. Filling out the paper order form on Picture Day saves you 15% off from online ordering process. However, online ordering is available for those who prefer.

RECITAL VIDEOS – Same process as 2023!

With expensive Recital DVD's becoming obsolete, we have decided to join the Imagine Dance Partnership Program this year. Every family participating in the 2024 Recital will receive a DIGITAL RECITAL VIDEO to download, post, share with grandparents, etc. **Each participating family account will be charged \$25 + tax on April 22nd**. This will save us nearly 60% off the old-school DVDs offered in the past. Videos include both nights' routines, including Opening Productions, Senior Tributes, and all Recital and Competition routines! As soon as Imagine confirms the cost, this will be relayed to you.

Our goal is to make the recital an organized, exciting, and stress-free experience for everyone involved.

Payments & Refunds

Recital costume orders can take 12 weeks or more for delivery. Costume manufacturers do not accept cancellations or offer refunds; therefore, Studio 320 does not offer refunds on costume deposits or payments.

Costume Cost

All recital costumes are \$80 + retail sales tax. Costumes will not be distributed until accounts are paid in full. No refunds will be made if a parent or guardian withdraws a child from class after costumes have been ordered and prior to the recital. (If you lose or damage your costume or accessories, you will be responsible for cost and rush fees for the studio to ship replacements, if possible.)

Alterations

Alterations are sometimes needed after the costumes have been distributed and are the responsibility of the student's parent or guardian. Often you can do minor adjustments of straps with a couple safety-pins. If you have questions or need advice, please see the front desk.

Distribution

As stated, costumes will be distributed during the last 15 minutes of your child's regularly scheduled class(es) during the week of April 8-11. Please have 1 parent in attendance as you will receive specific instructions on shoes, tights, and more. Costumes will not be sent home with students unless a parent/guardian is present. If you are not available on these assigned distribution dates, you may pick up your child's costume at the front desk. **Please try on your costume as soon as you bring it home.** This allows you to take inventory of all pieces and accessories and determine whether alterations are needed. Doing this in the weeks prior to recital minimizes stress at performance time.

Costume Care

Please label all costumes, shoes, accessories, and tights with your child's name. Place the costumes in a garment bag with your child's name on the outside. Pack accessories in a clear plastic bag labeled with your child's name. Hang and steam all costumes prior to performance. Do not wash costumes in your washing machine. Remove any tags that could hang out of the costume. If costume straps do not have snaps or are not attached, please sew or pin them prior to Recital day. Never criss-cross the straps in back unless specified by the teacher. Many costumes come with headpieces, gloves or hats. These will be handed out, and the teacher will determine how the headpieces will be worn. If your costume is "scratchy" due to sequins, you may add a strip of tape or felt to the inside. *(Pro Tip: try "Nexcare" first aid tape made by 3M, found near the bandaids. It sticks right to the inside of your costume and helps reduce irritation to the skin.)*

Steaming & Tutus

IMPORTANT! Please steam wrinkled costumes and tutus before the Recital. Hang tutus upside down in your garment bag to keep fluffy!

Quick Costume Changes

During the recital, some students may have quick costume changes. **Moms MUST come backstage to help your dancer during quick changes.** A special area and instructions will be given to you upon arrival at the show.

Tights, Shoes, Hair & Makeup

To ensure that there are no discrepancies in color and style (noticeable on stage/video/pictures) students are required to have the same brand. Other brands, pantyhose, etc. are NOT permitted. No tights should be dirty or have ANY holes, tears, or runs in them for pictures or performance. Our backstage staff will have extra tights on hand at recital – please see us if you have any problems.

Shoes

Each class/routine will require a specific color/style of dance shoes. Shoes should be purchased through **Dance Designs** in Liberty, MO. A special handout will be emailed to your class with exact shoes/tights/costume pieces/hair/makeup for your convenience. See the office with any questions or issues.

Undergarments

Underwear is not to be worn with leotards/costumes. (Your tights act as your underwear.) If you absolutely must wear underwear, they should be skin tone and should not show. Our older dancers may wear any necessary undergarments that are not noticeable in costume. Bras should be skin tone in color and have clear straps or be backless/strapless. “Sticky bras” can be found at Target, Walmart, Amazon, etc. and typically work for almost all costume styles. **See your teacher or the front desk for suggestions or questions – we can find a solution for ANY costume problem!**

Makeup

All female students are required to wear stage makeup for the recital: foundation, powder, bronzer, lipstick in a “true red” shade, blush, dark brown eye shadow (in crease) with ivory shadow on brow bone and lid. Black eyeliner (top eyelid) and black mascara (top and bottom lashes.) Fake lashes are optional. Lightly enhance eyebrows with shadow or pencil. We want all your dancer’s features and expressions to be seen on video and under stage lighting!

BOYS: We do not require boys to wear stage makeup.

PRESCHOOLERS: Please use your own discretion with Preschool age dancers, as application can be tricky and skin can be sensitive. Many preschool moms choose to do some eye shadow, blush and lipstick - and some even attempt a little mascara for willing dancers! ☺ You just want some definition under the stage lights.

ABSOLUTELY NO...

Colorful nail polish, fake tattoos, watches or jewelry, hair or body glitter, accessories, etc. allowed on the Recital stage. Real tattoos should be covered with stage/tattoo makeup. Acrylic/gel nails should be French manicure or natural in color. For safety reasons, no extra-long or sharp/pointed nails are allowed on stage. Small stud earrings are OK if you just got your ears pierced.

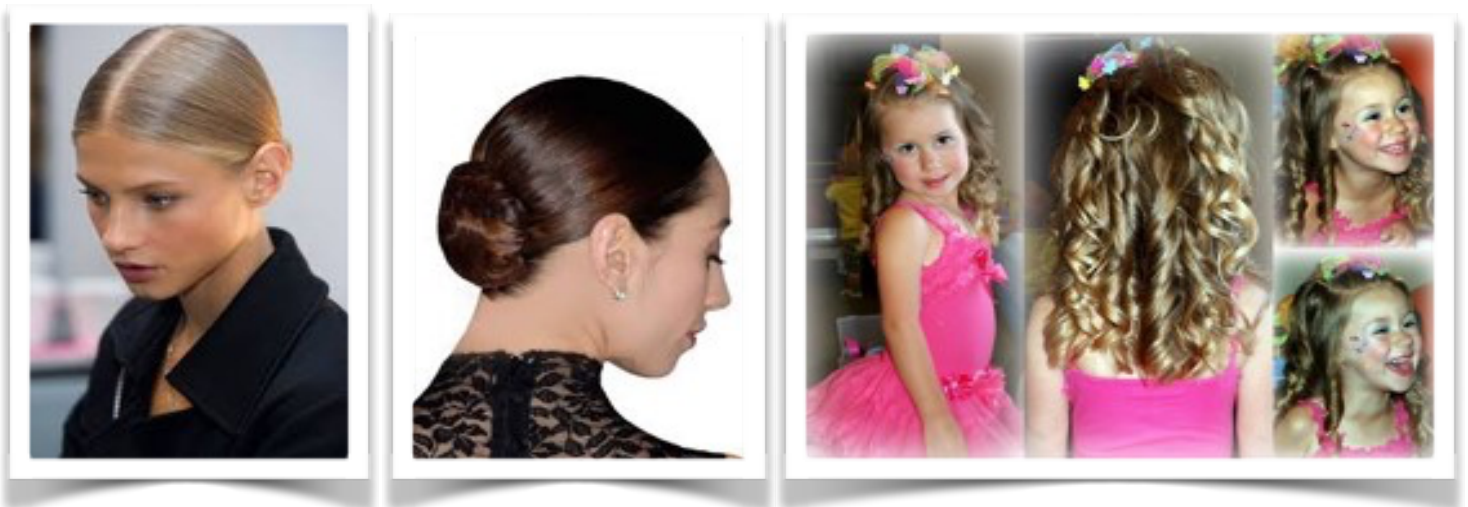


Hair for KINDERGARTEN & UP

Uniform hairstyles are required for the stage. **Girls must wear their hair SLICKED into a LOW BUN, with a MIDDLE PART. A hairnet is MANDATORY.** Donuts/bun-makers are optional. Lots of hair pins and gel/hairspray required. You'll need to touch-up hair (and makeup) at each costume change during the recital.

If your hair is very short or textured, please choose a style that works best for your class & hair accessory. See Tara or Office for ideas or questions.

Boys should wear hair styled with product that works best for you.



Hair for PRESCHOOL (Tiny 2, Preschool, and Pre-K Classes)

Preschool performers may wear hair in ANY style that works best for your hair type and that compliments your costume's hair accessory. Curled, sides pulled up, ponytail, piggies, braids, etc. Make sure it's out of her face and set with hairspray/product. **Boys** should wear hair styled with product that works best for you.

Planning & Preparation

Gather all costumes, accessories, shoes, hairnets & makeup several days in advance so you'll know if something is missing or isn't right. Make a checklist of your child's routines, listing the costume, tights, shoes, and any accessories and refer to it. Triple check everything before you leave for the theater!

Snacks

Please send your dancer with a DISPOSABLE WATER BOTTLE (absolutely NO juice, soda, flavored water) LABELED WITH THEIR NAME! If you must bring a snack, it needs to be clean & safe. No peanut products – and nothing chocolaty, cheesy, or messy that can ruin faces/makeup/costumes before performing.

Dressing Room Etiquette

Students must respect other students' space and property in the dressing rooms. Volunteers will be supervising the dressing rooms and helping Moms & Dancers with quick-changes & bathroom breaks. Games and activities will be provided. Please leave toys and devices with parents.

Backstage

For security purposes, guests and friends are not permitted backstage or in the dressing rooms during the recital, including before and after the show. There is a lot of backstage activity in a limited space, and dressing rooms are private areas. Those who wish to greet performers after the show, or to present flowers and do photos, may do so in the lobby area. Photo op areas will be set up just for you!

Dance Moms will be able to enter the dressing rooms during the show to assist their child with costume changes.

Audience Etiquette

- Enthusiastic applause is encouraged!
- Tickets are required for all children age 4+ or who are sitting in a seat (student performers do NOT need a ticket)
- Children should not bring devices with sounds and/or lights that could be a distraction for other audience members.
- Audience members should remain seated during all performances. Allowing children to run around or disrupt the performance is unfair to other parents/audience members.
- If you do leave the auditorium during the show, please do so between routines. You will only be allowed back into the auditorium between routines.
- No eating, drinking, or smoking is allowed in the theatre.
- During the recital, when the dancers are not onstage, they must remain in the dressing rooms with their Volunteer Class Moms.

IMPORTANT!

PHOTO/VIDEO POLICY - No video or flash photography is permitted during the recital. Our videographer (Imagine Dance) will provide professional recital videos to all families!

Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedures

The Music Hall is a very large facility which requires us to have a very specific backstage plan. An email will be sent detailing student drop off and pick up procedures. This will be a secure process to ensure the safety of our dancers. As always, only parents with a "VIP" badge will be permitted to pick-up children backstage. VIP badges will be issued to you at check in before the show.

All dancers should be picked up backstage after they finish dancing for the evening. We highly encourage our dancers to join their family in the audience to continue watching the remaining show! Otherwise, you are free to leave the facility following your final performance.

Parking

Per the Kansas City Music Hall, in regards to parking, please read their statement below.

“Due to structural damage and deteriorating conditions initially identified by engineers just prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, City officials are closing the Auditorium Parking Garage under Barney Allis Plaza on Monday, April 15, 2024.

The garage was constructed in 1954 and last renovated in 1984. Since that time, as many of you have previously been notified, we have experienced significant structural issues which are now beyond repair based on the age of the facility. Upon closure, the abatement process will begin to prepare for demolition.

Alternative parking options have been identified to accommodate attendees during closure. The spaces are a 2-7 minute walk to the Kansas City Convention Center. There is also a park and ride location at Union Station, which is approximately a 20-minute ride by the KC Streetcar and short walk to the Convention Center.

Parking near the Convention Center

The Kansas City Convention Center is located in the heart of downtown Kansas City, Mo. All major highways feed into the downtown making easy access to all convention and entertainment facilities. There are multiple parking options to access Convention Center facilities including the Municipal Arena, Music Hall, Grand Ballroom, Little Theatre, Conference Center and Bartle Hall.
